Information

The Kennebunk Parks and Recreation Department is committed to promoting and providing our community residents with outstanding service, recreational programs, parks and facilities that create leisure opportunities in a safe and healthy environment which meets the needs of participants and enhances their quality of life.

Volunteers: Volunteers are essential to this department. They enable us to provide a much larger program format at a considerable savings to the community. Volunteers in turn receive hours of enjoyment in an activity or program in which they have a strong interest. The department is always looking for more volunteers for special events and field trips, to set up programs, or for a program they might like to start. Please help us set up a volunteer list by contacting the department and then by giving a few hours of your time to a very worthwhile program or activity. Please be advised all volunteers must fill out a volunteer application and go through the interview process before being considered to volunteer for any program.

Check your receipt at time of registration and prior to participating in a program: Participants may only participate in the time slot, day, and/or session that they have registered for as printed on their receipt. Please understand often times programs fill to capacity and we may not be able to change your time slot, day, and/or session after leaving the office, regardless of a change you would like made or an error that you would like corrected.

<u>Program Times:</u> It is very important that parents not only know the time a program begins but also what time it is over so that arrangements are made to have their child picked up on time. The department charges a late fee to any parent or guardian who is late picking up a child. Please be conscious of this and respect the private time of our staff, most of whom have other jobs or personal matters to which they need to attend.

Late Fees: 10-15 minutes \$10, 15-30 minutes \$15, anything over 30 minutes is \$30. If the participant's parent, guardian or adult approved to pick up the child is late in picking up their child 2 times throughout the duration of the program and/or more than 40 minutes late at any time, a meeting will be set up with the Director to discuss if the participant will be allowed to continue the program. The participant will not be able to participate in the program until this meeting has taken place. Payment of late fees is expected at the time of pick-up. If we do not receive payment at time of pick-up, it will be charged to your account and must be paid in order to register for any further programs.

Schedule Times: The department reserves the right to cancel or rearrange any of the programs listed. Refunds will be issued if a program is canceled or a change does not fit your schedule.

School Facilities: Please be aware that R.S.U. #21 has priority over all school facilities. This may possibly cause recreation programs to be canceled or a time/location change. Should this happen, we will make every effort to contact participants.

Programs for the Disabled: The programs listed in this catalog are available for all to participate. If you or your child have a disability and are not sure whether your needs will be met in any program or activity, please contact the Director. We may be able to adjust the program to meet your needs or find another to suit you.

American with Disabilities Act:

In accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, the Town of Kennebunk invites you to identify any physical or mental disability or behavior that would preclude you from fully participating in the Kennebunk Parks & Recreation programs. The Town is fully committed to complying with the requirements of the Acts set forth above. In this regard, the Town, to extent required by law, will provide reasonable accommodations to participants who require them in order to participate in the program. Individuals with disabilities are not required to self-identify at any time. However, the Town is only required to provide reasonable accommodations for known disabilities. The Town is not required to search medical files in order to determine the existence of a disability. If your child needs a reasonable accommodation(s) in order for your child to participate in our program, you must contact the office a minimum of 1 week before the program.

<u>Discipline:</u> If your child misbehaves or does not adhere to the department's rules and regulations and/or is not listening to our instructors while participating in any of our programs a written warning will be issued. Written warnings must be signed by the participant's parent or guardian. Written warnings are kept on file at the office and are cumulative. A copy of this written warning will be forwarded to the Director for review and possible disciplinary action which includes any or all of the following: Conditional Participation; Suspension Single/All Program(s), Expulsion; Single/All Programs(s), and/or Restitution. Any disciplinary action will be imposed without program fee refunds. Please be advised that the department reserves the right to remove a participant from a program at any time during the course of the program if the department feels that the participants actions are a threat to the well being and safety of the other children and/or staff.

Smoking Policy: In compliance with Maine State Law, there will be no smoking allowed while participating in any recreation program/activity or while in any recreation facility. The Kennebunk Parks & Recreation Department does hereby declare that its recreation facilities are tobacco-free zones and specifically restricts the use of any tobacco product, including, but not limited to cigarette, cigars, and chewing tobacco, on, in, or at any athletic facility, playground, or assembly under the authority of the Town of Kennebunk Parks & Recreation Department.

Find A Mistake?: It is our policy to include something for everyone. Since some people like to find errors, we leave a few in our catalog just to meet this need. Please be aware that we reserve the right to correct and change any of the information in our catalogs, flyers or any other print generated from our office.

<u>Pictures:</u> We randomly choose pictures of adults and children who participate in our programs to be printed in our publications and to be sent out to area publications. If you or your child do not wish to have his/her picture published, please be sure to let us know immediately at registration.

T-Shirts: Please be aware that you must be registered at least 10 days prior to the program start date to receive a t-shirt, if the camp/program includes a t-shirt.

<u>Vandalism:</u> Each year Kennebunk taxpayers must cover the cost of repairing or replacing park facilities and vegetation that has been willfully destroyed. Since parks are unsupervised, it is difficult for Park Staff to catch the vandals who cause this damage. You can assist by reporting any acts of vandalism to the Police at 985-6121.

Discovering Wiscasset, Castle Tucker,



Nickels Sortwell House, & Downtown Wiscasset

Dramatically sited on a hill overlooking the Sheepscot River, Castle Tucker tells the story of a prominent shipping family's life over a period of 150 years. From 1858 until the end of the 20th century, the Tucker family survived economic upheavals, emotional turmoil and a rapidly changing outside world. Built in 1807, the house was later redecorated & furnished to Victorian. A visit to Castle Tucker offers a glimpse into the everyday life of Mollie & Richard Tucker & their 5 children at the turn of the 20th century. With 3 generations of family possessions on view, Castle

Tucker is a time capsule that echoes with the voices of a remarkable Maine family. The Nickels-Sortwell House is a National Historic Landmark & one of the region's finest Federal-style houses. Built by Captain William Nickels, it epitomizes the brief period when shipbuilding

& the maritime trade brought wealth and sophisticated tastes to this coastal Maine village. Jefferson's Embargo of 1807 devastated Wiscasset economically. The Nickels family was forced to sell the mansion in 1814. During much of the 1800s it served as a hotel for a growing number of summer visitors to Maine's coast. In 1899 industrialist & banker Alvin Sortwell, the former mayor of Cambridge, MA, bought the house. The Sortwell family's Wiscasset roots reached back to the early 1700s. Wentworth By the Sea, now A Marriott Hotel & Spa commands the island of New Castle, one of New Hampshire's oldest settlements. Mailed in registrations are processed <u>AFTER</u> walk in registrations. Or:

Come to our office located on the 3rd floor of the Kennebunk Town Hall during normal business hours. We are sorry, but the department cannot accept telephone registrations or reservations. All parents/guardians must sign a release waiver located on our registration form or the release waiver on our payment receipt to sign up for a program. Friends or other family members may NOT register another person without a registration form signed by a child's parent/guardian or by the other adult wishing to participate. Please be aware: Please be aware that we do not allow person(s) to be dropped off or attend a program without being registered prior to the program start date. Due to liability concerns if a person arrives at a program and is not on the participant list that person will not be able to participate until such time as proof of registration is given to the program coordinator.

Non-Resident Fees:

There is an additional fee of \$5 per program per participant unless otherwise stated for anyone not residing in Kennebunk. In some programs this fee may be higher.

Assistance:

Fees are charged in almost all of our program/events to help offset the cost to the town's taxpayers. If for any reason you are unable to pay the cost of a program/event, please contact the Recreation Director to work out a payment agreement or to receive assistance. Any payment agreements must be paid in full prior to the start of the program for the participant to attend. Payment agreements are available to Kennebunk Residents only.

Participant Age/Grade:

All school age children (Grades K-12) are required to be the age/grade requested by the start of the program or turning the correct age during the length of the program to be eligible to participate. All others are required to be the age/grade requested by the start of the program. No exceptions will be made.

Prorating cost for non-contractual programs that are already in operation:

If a participant would like to join a program after it has started and the program has space available the department will prorate the fee on a program by program basis; however, a \$5 late sign up fee will be added. Please be aware this does not include: Summer Day, Teen X-Treme or one-day participation programs.

Refund Policy:

In order to be considered for a refund, the participant and/or parent/guardian must put the request in writing via email or fax on the day they would like to withdraw from a program. Please be aware checks can take a minimum of 3 weeks to be processed and will be mailed to the address we have on file.

Due to the processing time and expense associated with program refunds, there will be a refund fee per program, per person which will be deducted from your program refund. The refund fees are:

\$15 fee per person for programs \$50 and under & \$30 fee per person for programs over \$50.

The Parks & Recreation Department will grant refunds by check for programs and activities under the following conditions:

- 1. When there is a conflict between the schedule of a program and the participant, and the participant has not attended any class whatsoever; a full refund can be obtained from the department, except in the case of a contractual program or it causes the department to cancel the program or comes at the expense of the Town of Kennebunk. This refund request must be made no later than the start of the programs second class at which time Guideline 4 will be in effect.
- 2. Should the participant have any injury or sickness that prevents him/her from completing the program, he/she will be entitled to a full refund if he/she has not attended any sessions, or a pro-rated refund based upon the number of sessions that will not be attended, except in the case of a contractual program.
- 3. When the participant attends the first day of the program and realizes he/she is not interested or can not afford, for example, additional costs of clothing, equipment, etc., then a full refund will be given, except in the case of a contractual program or it causes the department to cancel the program or comes at the expense of the Town of Kennebunk.
- 4. No refund will be given after the start of the second program's class, except for Guideline 2.
- 5. Contractual Program Refund Policy: Contractual programs are programs where a verbal or written contract has been made by this department with an individual or business to run the program. Refunds will be granted to contractual programs only in the event that the issuing of this refund does not come at the expense of the Town of Kennebunk. All refunds must be requested at least 3 working days prior to the program start date. A refund will not be granted if the department has already issued the program payment to the contracted business, or the issuing of the refund puts the program under the minimum number of participants needed to run the contracted program. In the event of a one-day program, a refund request must be made a minimum of one business day, excluding weekends and holidays, prior to the start of the program.
- 6. Summer Day Refund Policy: In order to be considered for a refund, the parent/guardian must put the request in writing via email or fax on the day they would like to withdraw from the program. Once the request has been received, a meeting with the Recreation Director will need to be scheduled in order to determine if a refund is possible.
- 7. Teen X-Treme Refund Policy: In order to be considered for a refund, the parent/guardian must put the request in writing via email or fax on the day they would like to withdraw from the program. Once the request has been received, a meeting with the Recreation Director will need to be scheduled in order to determine if a refund is possible.
- 8. Just For Kids Club Refund Policy: *A \$50 fee will be deducted from refund per child if cancelled before the program starts. After the start date a two week notice is required of all participants before leaving or making a schedule change prior to the end of the program. Each time a schedule change is made, a \$10 change fee per change occurrence, per participant will be charged.
