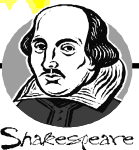
All performances are fun and exciting for Shakespeare experts and beginners alike

And when a sassy shepherdess sets her sights on Rosalind, the madcap musical adventure really begins. Come see Shakespeare's funniest pastoral comedy as it was meant to be seen – in the great outdoors.

**Othello** - This summer, MaineStage Shakespeare presents the ultimate tale of jealousy and betrayal. Each session campers will have the opportunity to write a short play to be performed as a "curtain raiser" for that week's Saturday afternoon MaineStage Shakespeare show.
